Throughout the 20<sup>th</sup> century British organ builders printed glossy brochures to advertise their instruments. The brochures often contain information that may not be available elsewhere, such as details of opening recitals, and sometimes brief histories of the organ. The brochures in this catalogue are usually in very good condition with only slight signs of wear or age.

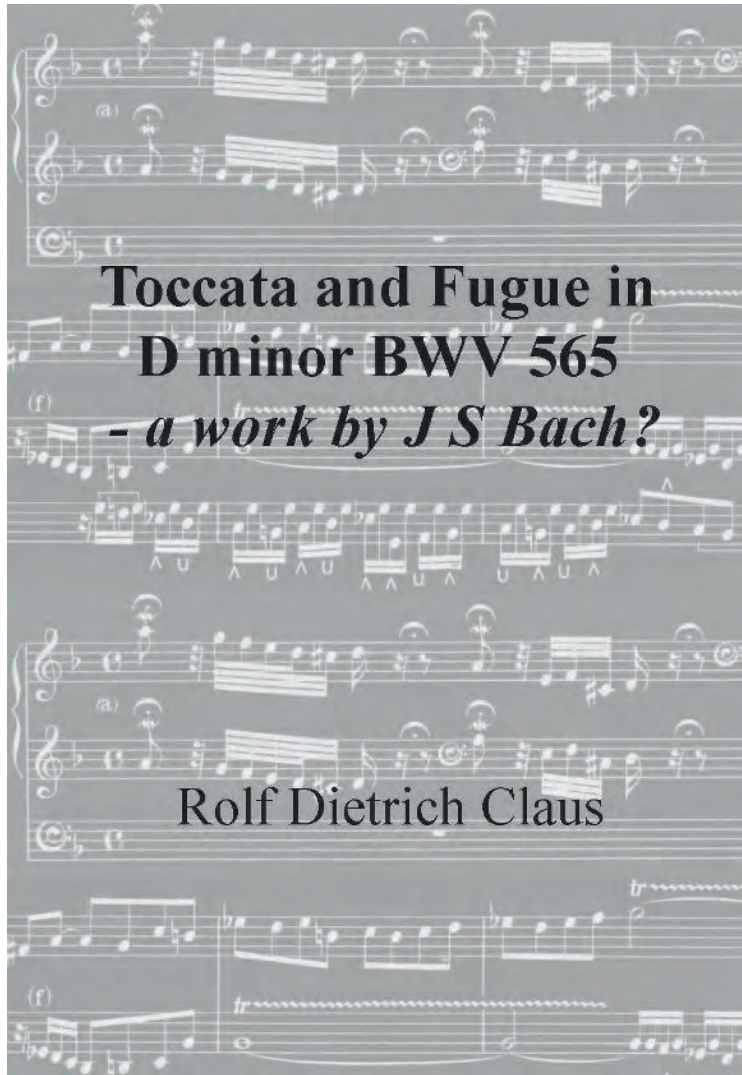
